
University of Illinois System—New Transfer Program

The University of Illinois System is excited to announce a new <u>transfer-focused initiative</u>, which includes a guaranteed transfer admissions program into any of the three campuses – Chicago, Springfield, and Urbana-Champaign. Effective the 2022-2023 academic year, qualified students will be guaranteed admission into UIC, UIS, or UIUC through 'The U of I Transfer Guarantee' if they meet all following requirements:

- have enrolled only at an Illinois community college after graduating from an Illinois high school
- and have earned a minimum of 36 graded, transferable semester hours at the time of application to the university
- and have attained a minimum grade point average of 3.0 in all transferable course work completed at the time of application to the university and have satisfied the university's English language proficiency requirement.

Several majors have specific requirements for admission beyond what is outlined in the requirements above and are also subject to enrollment constraints. Applicants may be admitted to alternative programs due to these limitations. Explore each university's transfer admissions websites (<u>UIC</u>, <u>UIS</u>, <u>UIUC</u>) for specific program requirements. This admissions program does not supplant or preclude existing transfer programs and partnerships but adds yet another exciting option for transfers into any of the University of Illinois campuses.


ICCHE Board Member Recognitions

SIUE Wins International Award

The continuing education unit at Southern Illinois University Edwardsville in Edwardsville has won an International Award in lifelong learning for Best Brochure by the Learning Resources Network (LERN), the largest association in continuing education in the world.

The award for 2022 was only one of seventeen given at LERN's big annual conference this year, attended by 1,755 professionals in lifelong learning from all over the United States and Canada.

"The award is for innovation in the field of continuing education and serving communities," stated LERN President William A. Draves. "These awards enhance the quality and involvement in continuing education, an absolutely critical component to individual and community quality of life and prosperity, especially now."

"With more than 100 award nominations every year, gaining an International Award is an outstanding achievement," Draves said.

In announcing the award, Draves noted: "The SIU brochure was excellent. They used a LERN brochure critique to rework their entire catalog. They revised the table of contents, course descriptions, and created highly visual and engaging interior pages. They increased their distribution radius and saw fall 2021 registrations increase 17% over the pre-pandemic fall 2019 term."

LERN serves over 800 organizations throughout the United States and Canada that are engaged in providing continuing education to their communities.



The Karen Swan Research Symposium

UIS is planning a free, virtual research symposium to honor the research contributions of Dr. Karen Swan, the James J. Stukel Distinguished Professor of Educational Leadership, to the field of online learning. The Karen Swan Research Symposium will be held on April 1, 2022 from 11 am-2 pm. Expert panels are being planned on the topics that were of interest to Dr. Swan, including the Community of Inquiry, Data Analytics & Predictive Modeling, and Technology-Enhanced Learning. Dr. Swan, who passed away September 5, 2021, was a plenary speaker at the 2016 ICCHE Annual Conference.





The University of Illinois Springfield's <u>ION Professional eLearning Programs have been honored with the 2021 University Professional and Continuing Education Association (UPCEA)</u>

<u>Outstanding Program Award</u>. ION supports the practice and innovation of online learning for faculty, staff and administrators in K-12 and higher education. More than 300 schools, colleges and universities across the country and world have utilized ION to stay current on emerging best practices in online learning. The UPCEA award, in part, honors ION's response to the COVID-19 pandemic, as overall enrollment in ION courses increased 260% between 2019 and 2020 as more schools embraced online and hybrid programs. The number of K-12 educations participating in ION programs increased 190% from 2018 to 2020.

ION adapted to offer courses during the first wave of the pandemic in condensed 4-week sections for individual colleges and universities, so instructors could explore specific issues affecting their institutions. ION program content was also updated in 2020 to provide K-12 specific information to meet the different needs and concerns for this group of educators and students. ION currently provides efficient, low-cost, and effective certifications for educators in three critical areas: 1) Master Online Teacher; 2) Master Online Leader and Administrator; and 3) Digital Accessibility. ION certificates are based on the idea that in order to be a quality online instructor, it is important to know the fundamental elements of instruction, assessment and instructional design and have practical experience teaching others through discussion boards, interactive activities and experience designing course elements.
